For the Variety Crew, and I know for all our Bashers, giving Tassie kids a Fair-Go in life is vital, it is at the heart of what we do.



It's why we said yes to supporting the "Ride for Eddie" campaign, an initiative started by Eddie's Grandfather to raise funds for a vehicle for Eddie's family. Eddie has Pontocerebellar Hypoplasia type 4, a rare neurodegenerative disorder, and requires the use of his wheelchair and his family will need a vehicle that can be modified to accommodate it.

It's also why we're so happy to be able to grant two children, siblings Ella and Sebastian, a Variety Freya Fund gift. Both children have a diagnosis of Autism and several other challenges and their mother needed a laptop, printer and laminator, in order to facilitate the management of appointments for the children, the ability to print out and laminate visuals for them, and to enable them to have video calls with various support workers. This grant will make a significant difference to their lives on a day to day basis.



We believe that one of Variety's roles is to be the instigator and enabler of change and inclusion and as such we have set in motion various initiatives over the last 6 months that will enable us to catch more kids that would otherwise fall through the gaps. With your support, we have been able to instigate the Variety Day @ The Zoo, and enabled Tassie Mums to reach an additional 200 kids this year. We supported the inaugural Disabled Surfers Association Tasmania, with their "Lets Go Surfing" event - a first for Tassie, designed to enable those with disability to have a safe surf experience regardless of their ability. And earlier this month, we kicked off a major research study with UTAS, to examine the environmental and cultural challenges faced by disabled children in schools.

We have also been able to instigate the Variety RDAT Scholarship, which will help fund a minimum of 250 riding sessions. The 2013 TasBash teams had the honour of visiting the RDAT and we know our Bashers can attest to the great benefits that equine therapy gives to children. We searched the archives but couldn't find a photo of our current Bashers with the horses or RDAT members - however we did find one of Uncle Den explaining something to the principal of Strahan Primary School during that TasBash. Just exactly what he was explaining can only be left to the imagination.



Your support has enabled us to reach these children, and many more, and for that we are very grateful.
